INVITATION FOR BIDS

For the promotion and development of indigenous renewable energy resources in the country, improving energy mix and to arrest drain of precious foreign exchange on import of fossil fuels, the Federal Government (GOP) under the leadership of the Prime Minister of Pakistan has launched multiple solar power initiatives. Solarization of Public Sector Buildings through transparent competitive bidding process is one of the components of these initiatives.

Federal Shariat Court of Pakistan, Islamabad "Employer" invites bids for the "Design, Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of net-metering based Solar PV Systems" at its premises i.e. The Federal Shariat Court of Pakistan Main Building and the Hon'ble Judges Rest House, Islamabad from the Contractors/Firms registered with PPIB.

Single Stage – Two Envelope bidding process will be adopted. Bidding Documents containing detailed terms and conditions are available for download on e-PADS portal (www.eprocure.gov.pk), PPRA website (www.ppra.org.pk) and Federal Shariat Court's official website (www.federalshariatcourt.gov.pk). The price of the Bidding Document in respect of both premises is Rs.5000/- which must be purchased from Cash Branch, Lower Ground, Federal Shariat Court of Pakistan, Constitution Avenue,G-5/2, Islamabad on or before 16.10.2025, through cash payment, pay order or a bank draft in favor of DDO, Federal Shariat Court, Islamabad. The bids of only those Bidders will be considered who have purchased the Bid Documents/RFP.

All Bids must be submitted electronically through e-PADS system by 11:00 AM on 16.10.2025. Manual submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances. The electronic bids will be opened on the same day at 11:30 AM through e-procurement portal (www.eprocure.gov.pk). Bidders or their authorized representatives may attend the bid opening session, if they so desire. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security amounting to 3% of their total bid amount.
