

MR. JUSTICE CH. MOHAMMAD SIDDIQUE

Mr. Justice Ch. Mohammad Siddique was born on 31.12.1916. He passed his LL.B. Examination from University Law College, Lahore in 1943 and started legal practice at Lahore in 1947. He was appointed District Liaison Officer, District Ambala and Simla to evacuate refugees and recover abducted Muslim Women. He was seriously injured while attempting to recover an abducted Muslim Girl.

He restarted legal practice in 1949. He was leading Attorney of Supreme Court and was associated with a number of important constitutional cases disposed by the Court. He was elevated to the Bench of Lahore High Court in 1971 and retired as Judge in 1978.

In August 1979, he was appointed Chairman of Punjab Election Authority and in October, 1979 Chairman Appellate Tribunal Bench. He was appointed Judge Federal Shariat Court on 1.6.1981 and worked as such till 31.5.1985. He was a social worker and established a Free Hospital in village Gondal District Sialkot from his own resources.
